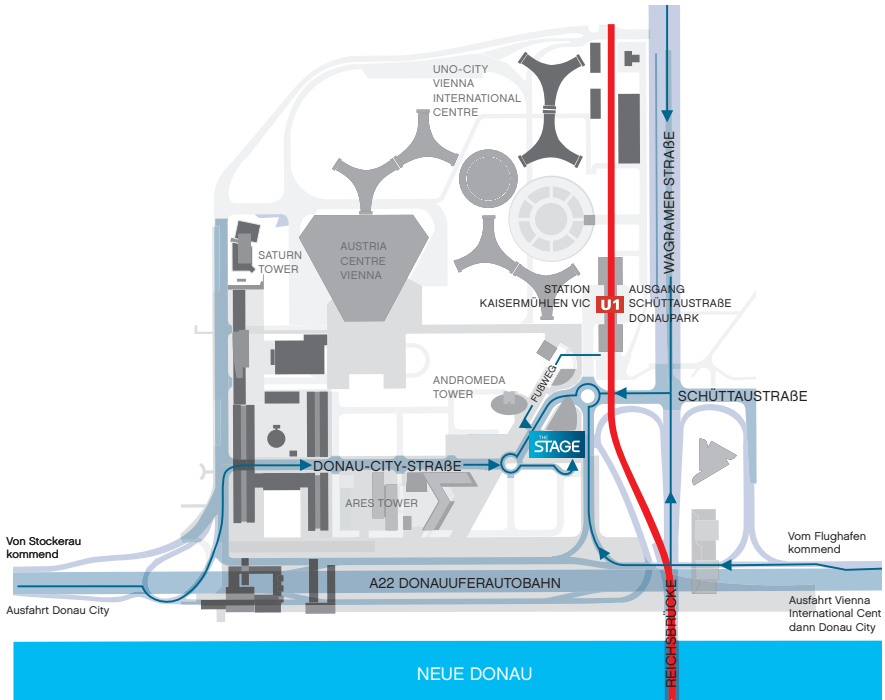

## Public Transport

### Metro U1 (red line)

Please take the stop „Kaisermühlen – Vienna International Center“ and exit in the direction of “Schüttaustraße/Donau-City-Straße”. From there it is an approx. 2-minutes walk

### Bus

The following bus lines stop right next to the venue:  
20A, 92A, 92B, Airport Bus, N90

### Car / Parking

Departure from the Reichsbrücke, coming from the city center at the first roundabout on the left, exit towards Donau-City-Straße. The entrance to the parking garage is immediately after the turnoff from the 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout. You can get a reduced parking ticket at the registration desk.

### ATTENTION:

The reduced parking ticket is only valid in the in-house TechGate Garage
